Resident Travel Advisories—Stay Home

It is strongly recommended that residents remain on campus and not visit public places, and that they postpone all upcoming travel, including flights, cruises, and third party transportation. Leaving campus should be limited to essential medical appointments only. Leaving campus only increases the risk of potential exposure for the entire campus. Residents who do choose to venture outside the gates will be required to pass through the screening checkpoint upon return. We request all residents to maintain physical distance, while remaining socially connected. Virtual visitation (Skype, FaceTime) and phone calls are great ways to remain connected.
